Captain's Wine List

Chardonnay

- Chateau St. Jean Robert Young** 2005 – Alexander Valley, Sonoma \$40
Light straw color, complex citrus zest, butterscotch caramel and vanilla.
- Bogle** 2007 – Clarksburg, California \$19
Green apple, ripe peach, very rich and full in mouth. Crisp finish.
- Chalone** 2005 – Monterey County \$46
Estate grown with flavors of brioche and stone fruit. Aged 10 months in oak. Impressive and very big.
- Souverain** 2007 – Alexander Valley, Sonoma \$30
Vibrant aromas of ripe pear, white peach and yellow apple. Excellent feel in mouth. Finish long and with citrus overtones
- Mayacamas** 2004 – Mt. Veeder, Napa Valley \$60
Straw color lean mineral, orange blossom. Very dry finish. A perfect chardonnay to lay down for cellaring.
- Sterling** 2006 – Napa Valley \$30
Rich creamy entry with ripe peach and apple with a long finish.
- Ghost Pines** 2006 – Napa/Sonoma \$28
A multi AVA varietal lush baked apple, lemon cream with apple and citrus. Tasty vanilla finish.

Petit Sirah

- Pedroncelli** – 2005 Sonoma Valley \$26
Rich opulent ruby color with ripe blackberry, black pepper and chocolate aromas. Deep and complex. Needs to breathe or be decanted to develop. Great cellar choice.

Cabernet Sauvignon

- Sterling** 2006 – Sonoma Valley \$40
Beautifully integrated ripe fruit velvety, tannins opulent rich fruit of blackberry, black cherry and violet. Aged 12 months in oak.
- Ghost Pines** 2006 – Napa/Sonoma \$28
A marvelous full, rich wine. Very supple on palate. Delicious Napa/Sonoma blend with ample fruit, long finish and light tannins.

Pinot Noir

- La Crema** 2007 – Sonoma Valley \$40
Full nose of crisp plum, cherry, and allspice with good body and fragrant nose.

Rose

- E. Guigal Tavel** 2005 – Rhone, France \$35
A true rose made from Grenache and Cinsault. Full bodied powerful with character and personality. Very aromatic, complex, dry and rose filled.

Merlot

Saddleback 2004 – Napa Valley \$58

A ripe, succulent mouth filling merlot with layers of complex black cherry, blackberry, and citrus. Truly one of the definitive merlots on the market.

Ghost Pines 2005 – Napa/Sonoma \$28

Fresh blackberry, deep red jam. Subtle nuttiness with dried oaks. character. Long soft finish.

Chateau St. Michelle 2005 – Columbia County, Washington \$28

Nose of strong black cherry, prunes and oak. Very dry with very pleasing finish.

Sterling 2005 – Sonoma Valley \$28

Central Coast vintners' Collection. Big blackberry aromas with toasty oak and vanilla. Long finish.

Champagne

Schramsberg blanc de Noir 2005 – Calistoga, California \$65

Lovely but complex pinot noir style with peach almond notes enhanced with hints of raspberry and sweet ginger that linger. Very elegant on the palate.
